Notes

- ¹ Charges for school fees, boarding fees and any additional tuition include VAT at 20%, unless indicated. VAT is not chargeable on certain other items which are either exempt or zero-rated.
- ² Sibling Discounts will be automatically applied where a family has two or more children in Year 1 and above. The discount is 5% for a second qualifying child and 10% for a third and subsequent children. The discounts will be applied to the fees of the eldest child/children in the family.
- ³·Early Years 3-4 year old funding for children in Reception will automatically be deducted from your bill. The amount each term will vary depending on the length of the term, and the prevailing funding rate.
- ³ An enhanced provision fee applies to all 2 year old and 3-4 year old funded hours. This includes Outdoor Learning, specialist music and sports, and all snacks and lunches.
- $^{\rm 4}$ Charges apply to both Pre-Prep and Prep before and after school care. Supper Club includes a hot supper.
- ⁵ Charge per pupil based on 30 x **30** minute lessons per academic year.
- ⁶ Charge per pupil based on 30 x **30** minute lessons per academic year.
- ⁷ Charge per pupil based on 15 x **30** minute lessons per academic year.
- ⁸ Pre-booked per pupil per journey and charged on an actual use basis. Discounts of between 5% and 25% will apply if a pupil's minibus use averages 5 or more journeys per week. Route details and more information are available from the Office.

Payment Options

Payment by bank transfer is preferred, but for all, we are pleased to continue to offer two direct debit options, either termly or in instalments. These arrangements are as follows:

- For the termly scheme, the school bill (comprising tuition fees and boarding fees for the forthcoming term, plus any disbursements in arrears for the previous term) will be collected in full on the due date, which is the first day of term.
- For the instalment option, the school bill (comprising tuition fees and boarding fees for the forthcoming term, plus any disbursements in arrears for the previous term) will be collected in three equal instalments during the term, as follows:- Autumn Term: September, October and November; Spring Term: January, February and March and Summer Term: May, June and July. These instalments will be collected on the first Friday of the relevant month.

We are also able to take payment for school bills by card, but there will be a 1.5% fee charged for this facility.
