Welcome to Bradfield House



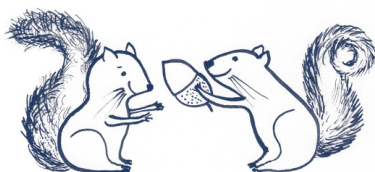
We can't wait to welcome you to our family!

When you arrive at school in the morning please drop your bag off on the bench outside Mr & Mrs Miell's flat.

Please ensure that the bag is clearly labelled as well as all of your belongings within.

If it is your first-time flexi boarding with us, or you are on a taster session, you will be scooped up when you come upstairs at 5.45pm and shown what to do.

BOARDING ROUTINE:

5:45pm

Come upstairs, get changed in your dorm and go straight to supper in the dining room

6.30pm

Evening Activities / Music Practice

7:15pm

Optional phone time in the boarding house and time to have an evening snack

7:45pm

Shower and change into PJs, dressing gown and slippers before free time in the house

8.30pm - Lights out (Years 3&4) 8.45pm - Lights out (Years 5&6)

9.00pm - Lights out (Year 7) 9.15pm - Lights out (Year 8)

THE NEXT DAY:

7.00am

Wake up and get changed ready for School

7.30am

Yummy breakfast in the dining room!

If you are going home that day then before you go to breakfast you must make sure you have all your belongings with you. You can leave your bag on the bench outside Mr & Mrs Miell's flat ready for collection at the end of the day.

You must collect your phone from the boarding office after School has finished.

8.00am

Breakfast finishes - School day begins!

What if I need someone during the night?

There is always a member of staff on duty overnight to look after you if needed. Next to all the boarding house phones is a sheet telling you who is on duty that night and the three digit number to call.

Please do not worry about asking for help in the night - we are here to look after you and we do not mind being woken up!

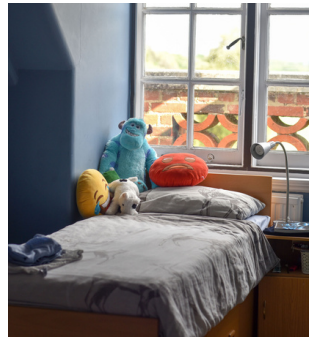


PACKING LIST
